SERVICE DETAILS:

- Comprehensive Assessment One on one discussion to identify and justify career interests and choices, identify possible additional barriers to succeeding in employment endeavors, identify appropriate services and assistance needed to succeed in obtaining favorable employment and identifying agency and community partners who may also assist.
- Veteran Individual Employment Plan A written
 comprehensive employment plan between the veteran and
 representative that establishes a path and actions needed
 to accomplish employment and training goals and
 establishes timelines for these actions and who is
 responsible for each action outlined in the plan. Plan also
 incorporates follow-up actions.
- Job Readiness Assistance Representatives can provide assistance with résumé preparation, interviewing techniques, application assistance, career exploration and labor market information.
- Coordination and Linkages Representatives have a network of community partnerships, veterans organizations and workforce center partners.
- Priority of Service Veteran and eligible spouse have services priorities in Dept. of Labor funded programs over their non-veteran counterparts. This includes all activities and programs conducted in and through our workforce centers. This means that when a funded resource has not been committed to a client, the veteran will receive that service or resource first.
